Kjell Aleklett is Professor of Physics and leader of the Global Energy Systems Group at Uppsala University, Sweden. His interest in global energy issues began in 1994. He cofounded ASPO and has been its President since 2003 and organised the first International Workshop on Oil Depletion in 2002.

Professor Aleklett has been called upon to testify before committees in several parliaments including the US House of Representatives Subcommittee on Energy and Air Quality and the Australian Senate Inquiry into Public Transport. His latest research is a critical review of the International Energy Agency's forecasts of steady growth in oil production until 2030.
